"Roadside Safety Check" Results Are In

Franklin Park, Illinois – Results are in from the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* Roadside Safety Check.

During the roadside safety checks, reducing the deadly dangers from drunk drivers was a top priority as Franklin Park Police Department conducted the first of ten road side safety checks, to arrest those who put themselves and others on the road at risk.

On November 14, 2015, Franklin Park Police conducted a road side safety check between the hours of 10 PM and 1 AM on the 10100 block of Grand Ave. Officers observed 566 vehicles passing through the detail sites and checked 90 vehicles. Out of the 90 vehicles checked 32 citations were issued. Included in the 32 citations were 8 registration violations, 7 seat belt violations, and 17 equipment violations.

The recent law enforcement crackdown was funded by federal traffic safety funds through the Illinois Department of Transportation and is part of the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over and Click It or Ticket* campaigns.
