Pursuant to the authority vested in the office of the Village President by the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6; the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 3305/11; and Ordinance Number 1920-G-80 of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, I, Barrett F. Pedersen, Village President of the Village of Franklin Park, do hereby declare that a State of Emergency continues to exist as of this date, June 15, 2020, and shall continue until such time as provided by Ordinance Number 1920-G-80.


On March 9, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois declared a state of emergency. On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak a pandemic. On March 20, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois issued Executive Order 2020-10, a "Stay at Home" order to slow the spread of COVID-19. On April 1, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois extended the disaster proclamation for an additional thirty (30) days. On April 1, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois issued Executive Order 2020-18 to extend the "Stay at Home" order through April 30, 2020. On April 30, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois extended the disaster proclamation for an additional thirty (30) days. On April 30, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois issued Executive Order 2020-32 to extend the "Stay at Home" order through May 29, 2020. On May 29, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois extended the disaster proclamation for an additional thirty (30) days. On May 29, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois issued Executive Order 2020-36 and Executive Order 2020-37 pertaining to the implementation of the Restore Illinois Plan through June 27, 2020.

The nature of the emergency is the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak.

During the existence of the State of Emergency, the Village President shall execute such authority as provided under the Illinois Municipal Code, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act and Ordinance Number 1920-G-80. This Declaration of a State of Emergency shall be filed with the Village Clerk as soon as practicable.


