- VI. STAFF REPORTS AND COMMENTS; DISCUSSION ON AGENDA ITEMS
  - 1. Ron Heller spoke about agenda item #10 regarding the renewal of the liability, property and workman's compensation insurance premiums with Illinois Counties Risk Management Trust (ICRMT)
  - 2. Joe Lauso spoke about agenda item #2 regarding providing for the maintenance of streets and highways under the Illinois Highway Code from May 1, 2014 to April 30, 2015, for the use of motor fuel tax funds in the amount of \$714,610.00 for the purchase of road salt. Mr. Lauro spoke about the rise in the cost of road salt. Mr. Lauro spoke about agenda item #7 regarding the approval of the proposal from Dome Corporation of North America for emergency repairs to the salt dome conveyor system. Mr. Lauro spoke about agenda item #6 regarding the approval of the bid from C.J. Rose & Sons, Incorporated for emergency repairs and replacement of the roof on the clearing pump station. The entire roof was blown off during a recent wind storm
  - 3. Chief Iovinelli reported the health advisory information he emails to the board members has slowed down. Chief Iovinelli spoke about the 2014 Firefighter of the Year Award going to Ignacio Garcia. Mr. Garcia has been with the Fire Department for 10 years. Chief Iovinelli requested to go into executive session for employment, compensation, discipline, performance or dismissal of certain employees; and also for collective bargaining negotiations matters
  - 4. Chief Witz spoke about agenda item #8 regarding the motion to approve the renewal of a preventative maintenance agreement with Sherman Mechanical Incorporated, to service the HVAC and cistern systems at 9451 Belmont Avenue. Chief Witz showed the board members some items that are used for roadside safety checks

- 5. Carmen Cupello spoke about repairs beginning December 3<sup>rd</sup> in the kitchen at Fire Station #1. Mr. Cupello spoke about speaking with Lisa Anthony about the health inspector position that has opened up with the retirement of Paul McDonald. Mr. Cupello reported the contractor for the Village Hall roof is evaluating the weather forecast to see if the roof can be completed before the end of the year
