MEETING MINUTES**

---

**Call to Order:** The meeting for the Police & Fire Commission was called to order by Chairman Maritza Souchet at 6:03.

**Roll Call/Quorum:** Present: Commissioner Maritza Souchet, Commissioner Joe Patti and Commissioner Irene Herrera. Also present: Trustee Randy Peterson, Police Chief Mike Witz, Fire Chief Steve Iovinelli, Deputy Chief Phil Ruch and Secretary Margarita Whaley. Also present Tommy Thomson.

**Approval of Minutes:** A motion to approve the September 2, 2014 minutes was made by Commissioner Patti and seconded by Commissioner Herrera with all in favor.

**Communications:**

**Trustee Petersen** ~Inquired about police testing. Commissioner Souchet said COPS/FIRE told her roughly 320 applications were taken, about 205 attended orientation and 169 came to physical testing. Testing went smoothly, but high school had 2 work orders and the location was slightly different than anticipated.

**Chief Iovinelli** ~Inquired about where & time for fire orientation and written test. Police station for both and 7 pm for orientation(10-16-14) and 9 am for written(10-18-14) with registration starting at 8 am. Also inquired about the amount of fire applicants - Sec. Whaley stated there was approximately 36, but the deadline was moved back to October 9th to allow for more applications to be taken.

**Sec. Whaley** ~ will be coming up with a timeline for changing Rules & Regulations because the village would like to attract more local candidates for police which may include a possible change in preference points and other ideas to be discussed at future meetings. 2015 meeting dates are being submitted to the village tomorrow.


