The Towers report by Sheree Victorian. They have started to make some of the empty apartments handicapped accessible. Sheree spoke about Well care, which has entered into a contract with Oak Street Health Clinics to help have positive outcomes for Medicare recipients.

Ruth Schwab commented that Leyden Township has a lot of programs for the senior citizens.

Lisa reminded everyone we will be hosting along with AT & T a Shred Day on August 27th in the old police station parking lot from 10am to 12pm.
