Franklin Park Police Department announces Labor Day impaired driving campaign results

(Franklin Park, IL.) – Franklin Park Police made six (6) DUI arrests during the recent Labor Day impaired driving campaign. In addition, thirty-four (34) seat belt citations were written – twenty-five (25) of which occurred during nighttime hours. Other enforcement included thirteen (13) speeding citations, five (5) distracted driving citations, thirty-eight (38) citations for other traffic offenses, and five (5) arrests for criminal offenses.

“Through the Labor Day enforcement effort, we helped to make our roads safer and remind motorists that impaired driving is not a game,” said Director Michael Witz.

The Franklin Park Police Department joined forces with other law enforcement agencies and highway safety partners throughout the state for the Illinois Labor Day “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over/Drive High. Get a DUI” enforcement campaign.

The effort was made possible by federal highway safety funds distributed by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
