### **Reports Successful Memorial Day 'Click It or Ticket' Campaign**

**[Franklin Park, IL]** —The Franklin Park Police Department today announced the results of its Memorial Day 2026 "Click It or Ticket" enforcement campaign aimed at increasing seat belt use and keeping roads safe during one of the busiest travel periods of the year.

"Thanks to the efforts of our officers, more drivers and passengers were reminded to buckle up, helping to prevent injuries and save lives," said Chief Ferris. "Every citation and safety check reinforces the message that seat belts work."

During the campaign, the Franklin Park Police Department took the following action:

- Forty-Seven (47) seat belt citations issued.
- One (1) child car seat citation.
- One (1) DUI arrest.
- One (1) no valid driver's license arrest.
- Six (6) uninsured motorist citations.
- One (1) speeding citation.
- Six (6) distracted driving citations.
- Thirty-Three (33) other various traffic citations.

The campaign's success reflects law enforcement's commitment to roadway safety and reinforces the message that buckling up saves lives.
