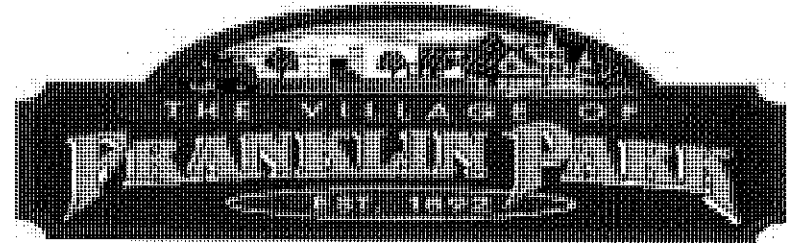

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER FIVE OF TITLE FIVE OF THE VILLAGE
CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS
(SYNTHETIC DRUG PROHIBITION)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village finds that products containing synthetic alternatives may be purchased for recreational use currently as an alternative to otherwise regulated controlled substances banned at the Federal, State, and local levels; and

WHEREAS, the Village finds that products containing synthetic cannabinoids, synthetic stimulants and synthetic psychedelic/hallucinogens are particularly attractive to children and young adults because of their availability in small packages at neighborhood stores at minimal costs, as well as due to the appealing names being given to these substances which are intended to attract children and young adults; and

WHEREAS, the Drug Enforcement Administration (the "DEA") has determined that the consumption of synthetic cannabinoids can cause adverse health effects such as agitation, anxiety, nausea, vomiting, tachycardia, elevated blood pressure, tremors, seizures, hallucinations, paranoid behavior and non-responsiveness; and

WHEREAS, the DEA has determined that consumption of synthetic stimulants affect alertness, and have been linked to severe psychotic episodes, increased heart rates, panic attacks, and hallucinations; and

WHEREAS, the American Association of Poison Control Centers has reported 2,700 synthetic cannabinoid-related calls to poison control centers in 49 different states; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities deem it necessary and desirable to prohibit the sale, delivery, possession and use of products containing synthetic cannabinoids, synthetic stimulants and synthetic psychedelic/hallucinogens in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 5-5-4 (“*Drug Abuse*”) of Chapter 5 (“*Criminal Code*”) of Title 5 (“*Police and Public Safety*”) of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection to read, as follows:

5-5-4-5: SYNTHETIC DRUGS:

A. Definitions.

For purposes of this chapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires different meaning:

1. *A product containing a synthetic alternative drug* means any product containing a synthetic cannabinoid, stimulant or psychedelic/hallucinogen, as those terms are defined herein such as, but not limited to, the examples of brand names or identifiers listed herein.

2. *Synthetic cannabinoid* means any laboratory-created compound that functions similar to the active ingredient in marijuana, tetrahydrocannabinol (THC), including, but not limited to, any quantity of a natural or synthetic material, compound, mixture, preparation, substance and their analog (including isomers, esters, ethers, salts, and salt of isomers) containing a cannabinoid receptor agonist, such as:

- JWH-007 (1-pentyl-2-methyl-3-(1-naphthoyl)indole)

B. Sale or Delivery.

It shall be unlawful for any business or person to sell, offer for sale, or deliver any product containing a synthetic cannabinoid, stimulant or psychedelic/hallucinogen.

C. Possession.

It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly possess a product containing a synthetic cannabinoid, stimulant or psychedelic/hallucinogen.

D. Use.

It shall be unlawful for any person to be under the influence of a synthetic cannabinoid, stimulant or psychedelic/hallucinogen.

E. Penalties.

A. Any person found to be in violation of Subsection B shall be subject to fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$750 for each violation thereof.

B. Any person found to be in violation of Subsection C or D shall be subject to fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$750 for each violation thereof.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.

Section 3. In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further finds in relation to the Proposed Conditional Use as follows:

1. The establishment, maintenance or operation of the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
2. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;

3. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the I-2 General Industrial District;
4. The Proposed Conditional Use will not affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood as the proposed plans will be an improvement upon the existing structure;
5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Proposed Conditional Use are already in place at the proposed property;
6. Ingress and egress for the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, shall minimally affect traffic congestion in the public streets; and
7. The Proposed Conditional Use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the I-2 General Industrial District.

Section 4. A conditional use, subject to the conditions set forth below, is hereby granted and issued to increase the maximum height of a highway advertising sign from forty-nine (49) feet to sixty (60) feet pursuant to Section 9-9-6(A)(3)(e) of the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance at a certain tract of property on 10625 Franklin Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois, and legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto.

This conditional use permit is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the Property be developed essentially in accord with the Plat of Survey submitted by the applicant dated as of 1/25/12;
2. That the maximum height be sixty (60) feet above the curb level of Interstate 294 per Village Code, and all permitting requirements designated by the State of Illinois and any other unit of government be adhered to and complied with at all times;
3. That the applicant comply with all other applicable rules and regulations of the Village of Franklin Park in the erection and operation of the proposed sign;
4. That the Property be used in accord with all other ordinances and laws of the Village of Franklin Park;
5. That the conditional use shall be limited to Lamar Advertising and shall not be transferable to a new lessee, sublessee or assignee except upon reapplication, hearing

and approval in the manner provided in the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance; and

6. This Ordinance shall be signed by the Applicant's authorized officer as well as the owner of record to signify its agreement to the terms hereof.
