A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, SUPPORTING RESTORATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTIVE FUND REVENUE

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, municipalities across the State of Illinois provide essential services to their residents that include public safety support, transportation and storm/wastewater infrastructure and community health services along with many others; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has maintained a long-held agreement with municipalities to support and invest in these local services through the Local Government Distributive Fund (the "LGDF"), which includes the collection and distribution of tax revenues on behalf of municipalities; and

WHEREAS, since the State income tax was adopted in 1969, State government has shared a percentage of total income tax collections through the LGDF with municipalities on a per capita basis in lieu of a local income tax; and

WHEREAS, these shared revenues have been significantly reduced by the State since 2011 from 10% to now 6.06%; and

WHEREAS, municipalities depend on LGDF dollars, which can account between 10% and 20% of a municipality's operating budget, to lessen the burden on taxpayers and reduce the reliance on property taxes; and

WHEREAS, Governor JB Pritzker has proposed that the Fiscal Year 2022 State budget include a further 10% reduction in the amount of LGDF revenue distributed to local governments; and

WHEREAS, this revenue reduction has been proposed at a time when municipalities are continuing to spend additional funds on the COVID-19 emergency response; and

WHEREAS, in addition to LGDF cuts over the years, the State has also reduced municipalities' share of the personal property replacement tax and increased sales tax collection fees while cities and villages have had to fund skyrocketing pension costs, which account for substantial budget increases each year; and

WHEREAS, those municipalities with fewer revenue sources, such as retail businesses with higher equalized assessed values on property, suffer the most and will be forced to explore increasing property taxes or cutting services amid further LGDF reductions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. That the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, urges the General Assembly and the Governor to restore LGDF payments to the promised 10% rate so municipalities across Illinois may provide basic levels of service and lessen the reliance on property taxes.
- Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.
 - Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this

Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE TO ALLOW FOR A "DAYCARE CENTER" USE WITHIN THE C-1 NEIGHBORHOOD CONVENIENCE DISTRICT (ZBA 21-06: 3541 ROSE STREET)

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, et seq., of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z-10), as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, a conditional use application, ZBA 21-06, has been submitted to the Village by Priscilla McWherter, as tenant, and Rose Franklin LLC, as owner, (collectively the "Applicants") to allow within the C-1 Neighborhood Convenience District a "daycare center" use (the "Conditional Use") on the property commonly known as 3541 Rose Street, Franklin Park, Illinois and as legally described and depicted on Exhibit A (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on May 5, 2021, on whether the Conditional Use should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing date; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and recommendations that the Conditional Use be granted, and the Corporate Authorities have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to grant the Conditional Use subject to the conditions identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. The President and Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.
- **Section 3.** In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further find in relation to the Conditional Use as follows:
 - 1. The establishment, maintenance, or operation of the Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
 - 2. The Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;

- 3. The Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the C-1 Neighborhood Convenience District;
- 4. The Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood as the proposed plans will be an improvement upon the existing structure;
- 5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Conditional Use are already in place at the Property;
- 6. Ingress and egress for the Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, shall minimally affect traffic congestion on the public streets; and
- 7. The Conditional Use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the C-1 Neighborhood Convenience District, except as such regulations may, in each instance, be modified by the Board of Trustees pursuant to the recommendations of the Zoning Board of Appeals.

Section 4. The Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth below, are hereby granted and issued for "daycare center" use in the C-1 Neighborhood Convenience District located at 3541 Rose Street, Franklin Park, Illinois, and as legally described on Exhibit A.

This Conditional Use is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the Conditional Use shall continue to comply with all conditions set forth in Ordinance 1920-Z-06 and these conditions shall also apply to the cross-hatched area on the site plan which was submitted as part of the record for this Conditional Use; and
- 2. That the Conditional Use at all times comply with all Village codes and regulations; and
- 3. That the Conditional Use shall be limited to Applicants, and shall not be transferable except upon reapplication, hearing and approval in the manner provided in the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance; and
- 4. This Ordinance shall be signed by the Applicants to signify acknowledgement of the terms hereof.

Section 5. The Applicants hereunder shall at all times comply with all Village

regulations and the terms and conditions of the Conditional Use and in the event of non-compliance, said permit shall be subject to revocation by appropriate legal proceedings.

- **Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.
- Section 7. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
