NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. That the above recital is found to be true and correct and is hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in its entirety.
- Section 2. Section 5-4-4 ("Direct Connection") of Chapter 4 ("Alarm Systems") of Title 5 ("Police and Public Safety") of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

5-4-4. DIRECT CONNECTION.

- (a) Application. Any business or other entity that is required by village code to provide a fire alarm or fire suppression system for their building shall make application to the Village of Franklin Park to direct connect their fire alarm by wireless transmission.
- (b) Approval or Disapproval. The chief of the fire department or his/her designee shall review the direct connection request and approve or disapprove the application. No application shall be denied without cause if the building is within the Village of Franklin Park. In the event that an application is disapproved, the applicant shall be informed that there may be submitted further request to the village board of trustees through the office of the village clerk for review of the disapproval of the application.
- (c) Connection Fee. Upon the approval of the chief of the fire department or his/her designee, the

- applicant can make or cause to be made such connection and shall be responsible for the payment of any direct expenses incurred by the village for third party services associated with the connection.
- (d) Monthly Charge. For each connection to the wireless fire alarm system, there shall be paid a monthly permit fee of thirty-three forty-eight dollars (\$3348.00), commencing on the first day of the month following the date of the connection. All permit fees provided for herein shall be payable by the alarm service company responsible for such connections.
- (e) Disconnection. The president and board of trustees fire chief may, at their his/her discretion, require the removal of any connection to an alarm system at any time that they determine it proper to so act.
- Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.
- **Section 4**. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- **Section 5**. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$11,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING DEBT CERTIFICATES, SERIES 2021A, OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFUNDING CERTAIN OUTSTANDING CERTIFICATES, **EVIDENCING** THE RIGHTS DEBT AN INSTALLMENT **PURCHASE PAYMENT** UNDER AGREEMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PROPOSED SALE OF SAID CERTIFICATES TO THE PURCHASER THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook Counties, Illinois (the "Village"), is a duly organized and existing municipality created and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, et seq., as amended, and is a governmental unit pursuant to the Local Government Debt Reform Act of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "Debt Reform Act"), and in particular, the provisions of Section 17(b) of the Debt Reform Act (the "Installment Purchase Provisions"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Installment Purchase Provisions, the Village previously entered into the following Installment Purchase Agreement:

INSTALLMENT PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THE 2013 PROJECT FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND FOR THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FUNDED BY THE NOT TO EXCEED \$13,500,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION DEBT CERTIFICATES, SERIES 2013

(the "Agreement") and, pursuant thereto, the Village President and Board of Trustees (the "Board") did provide for the issuance of certificates evidencing the debt thereunder, described as the \$13,500,000 General Obligation Limited Tax Debt Certificates, Series 2013, dated May 2, 2013 (the "Prior Certificates"), currently outstanding and unpaid in the amount of \$11,770,000; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to refund all or a portion of the Prior Certificates (said Prior Certificates to be refunded being referred to herein as the "Refunded Certificates") in order to realize debt service savings for the Village (the "Refunding"); and

WHEREAS, the Refunded Certificates are presently outstanding and unpaid and are binding and subsisting legal obligations of the Village, and shall be more fully described in the hereinafter-defined Certificate Order; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds of the Village are not available for the Refunding, and it will therefore be necessary to borrow money in an amount not to exceed \$11,000,000 for the purpose of paying such costs; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Debt Reform Act, the Refunded Certificates may properly be refunded by a new series of certificates as herein provided; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is desirable and in the best interests of the Village to avail of the provisions of the Debt Reform Act to issue certificates in an amount not to exceed \$11,000,000 for the Refunding; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the terms of the Refunded Certificates, the Refunded Certificates may be called for redemption in advance of their maturity, and it is necessary and desirable to make such call for the redemption of the Refunded Certificates, and provide for the giving of proper notice to the registered owners of the Refunded Certificates.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It and It Is Hereby Resolved by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.
- Section 2. Authorization. It is hereby found and determined that the Board has been authorized by law to borrow an amount not to exceed \$11,000,000 upon the credit of the Village and as evidence of such indebtedness to issue certificates of the Village to said amount, the proceeds of said certificates to be used to refund the Refunded Certificates, and that it is necessary and for the best interests of the Village that there be issued an amount not to exceed \$11,000,000 of the certificates so authorized.
- Section 3. Agreement is a General Obligation; Annual Appropriation. The Village hereby represents, warrants, and agrees that the obligation to make the payments due under the Agreement shall be a general obligation of the Village payable from any funds of the Village lawfully available for such purpose. The Village represents and warrants that the total amount due under the Agreement, together with all other indebtedness of the Village, is within all statutory and constitutional debt limitations. The Village agrees to appropriate funds of the Village annually and in a timely manner so as to provide for the making of all payments when due under the terms of the Agreement; however, the Certificates shall be valid whether or not an appropriation with respect thereto is included in any annual or supplemental appropriation adopted by the Village.

Section 4. Certificate Details. For the purpose of providing for the Refunding, there shall be issued and sold certificates of the Village in a principal amount not to exceed \$11,000,000, which shall be designated "General Obligation Refunding Debt Certificates, Series 2021A" (the "Certificates"), with such other designations and descriptions as may be set forth in the Certificate Order. The Certificates shall be dated the date of the issuance thereof, and shall also bear the date of authentication, shall be in fully registered form, shall be in denominations of \$5,000 each and authorized integral multiples thereof ("Authorized Denominations") (but no single Certificate shall represent installments of principal maturing on more than one date), or such other denominations as set forth in the Certificate Order, and shall be numbered 1 and upward. The Certificates shall become due and payable serially or be subject to mandatory redemption (subject to the option of prior redemption as hereinafter described) on the dates of each of the years, in the principal amounts and bearing interest at the rates per annum as set forth in the Certificate Order.

Interest on each Certificate shall be paid by check or draft of Amalgamated Bank of Chicago, Chicago, Illinois (the "Certificate Registrar" and "Paying Agent"), which shall be, payable upon presentation in lawful money of the United States of America, to the person in whose name such Certificate is registered at the close of business on the 15th day of the month next preceding the interest payment date. The principal of the Certificates shall be payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the principal office of the Certificate Registrar.

The Certificates shall be signed by the manual or facsimile signatures of the Village President and Village Clerk, and shall be registered, numbered and countersigned by the manual or facsimile signature of the Certificate Registrar, as they shall determine, and in case any officer whose signature shall appear on any Certificate shall cease to be such officer before the delivery of such Certificate, such signature shall nevertheless be valid and sufficient for all purposes, the same as if such officer had remained in office until delivery.

All Certificates shall have thereon a certificate of authentication substantially in the form hereinafter set forth duly executed by the Certificate Registrar as authenticating agent of the Village and showing the date of authentication. No Certificate shall be valid or obligatory for any purpose or be entitled to any security or benefit under this Ordinance unless and until such certificate of authentication shall have been duly executed by the Certificate Registrar by manual signature, and such certificate of authentication upon any such Certificate shall be conclusive evidence that such Certificate has been authenticated and delivered under this Ordinance. The certificate of authentication on any Certificate shall be deemed to have been executed by the Certificate Registrar if signed by an authorized officer of the Certificate Registrar, but it shall not be necessary that the same officer sign the certificate of authentication on all of the Certificates issued hereunder.

Section 5. Registration of Certificates; Persons Treated as Owners. (a) General. The Village shall cause books (the "Certificate Register") for the registration and for the transfer of the Certificates as provided in this Ordinance to be kept at the principal office of the Certificate Registrar, which is hereby constituted and appointed the registrar of the Village. The Village is authorized to prepare, and the Certificate Registrar shall keep custody of, multiple Certificate blanks executed by the Village for use in the transfer and exchange of Certificates.

Upon surrender for transfer of any Certificate at the principal office of the Certificate Registrar, duly endorsed by, or accompanied by a written instrument or instruments of transfer in form satisfactory to the Certificate Registrar and duly executed by, the registered owner or his or her attorney duly authorized in writing, the Village shall execute and the Certificate Registrar shall authenticate, date and deliver in the name of the transferee or transferees a new fully registered Certificate or Certificates of the same maturity of Authorized Denominations, for a like aggregate principal amount. Any fully registered Certificate or Certificates may be exchanged at said office of the Certificate Registrar for a like aggregate principal amount of Certificate or Certificates of the same maturity of other Authorized Denominations. The execution by the Village of any fully registered Certificate shall constitute full and due authorization of such Certificate and the Certificate Registrar shall thereby be authorized to authenticate, date and deliver such Certificate, provided, however, the principal amount of outstanding Certificates of each maturity authenticated by the Certificate Registrar shall not exceed the authorized principal amount of Certificates for such maturity less previous retirements.

The Certificate Registrar shall not be required to transfer or exchange any Certificate during the period beginning at the close of business on the 15th day of the month next preceding any interest payment date on such Certificate and ending at the opening of business on such interest payment date, nor to transfer or exchange any Certificate after notice calling such Certificate for redemption has been mailed, nor during a period of fifteen (15) days next preceding mailing of a notice of redemption of any Certificates.

The person in whose name any Certificate shall be registered shall be deemed and regarded as the absolute owner thereof for all purposes, and payment of the principal of or interest on any Certificate shall be made only to or upon the order of the registered owner thereof or his or her legal representative. All such payments shall be valid and effectual to satisfy and discharge the liability upon such Certificate to the extent of the sum or sums so paid.

No service charge shall be made for any transfer or exchange of Certificates, but the Village or the Certificate Registrar may require payment of a sum sufficient to cover any tax or other governmental charge that may be imposed in connection with any transfer or exchange of

Certificates except in the case of the issuance of a Certificate or Certificates for the unredeemed portion of a Certificate surrendered for redemption.

(b) Global Book-Entry System. The Certificates shall be initially issued in the form of a separate single fully registered Certificate for each of the maturities of the Certificates. Upon initial issuance, the ownership of each such Certificate shall be registered in the Certificate Register in the name of Cede & Co., or any successor thereto ("Cede"), as nominee of The Depository Trust Company, New York, New York, and its successors and assigns ("DTC"). All of the outstanding Certificates shall be registered in the Certificate Register in the name of Cede, as nominee of DTC, except as hereinafter provided. The Village President, the Village Clerk and the Certificate Registrar are each authorized to execute and deliver, on behalf of the Village, such letters to or agreements with DTC as shall be necessary to effectuate such book-entry system (any such letter or agreement being referred to herein as the "Representation Letter"), which Representation Letter may provide for the payment of principal of or interest on the Certificates by wire transfer.

With respect to Certificates registered in the Certificate Register in the name of Cede, as nominee of DTC, the Village and the Certificate Registrar shall have no responsibility or obligation to any broker-dealer, bank or other financial institution for which DTC holds Certificates from time to time as securities depository (each such broker-dealer, bank or other financial institution being referred to herein as a "DTC Participant") or to any person on behalf of whom such a DTC Participant holds an interest in the Certificates. Without limiting the immediately preceding sentence, the Village and the Certificate Registrar shall have no responsibility or obligation with respect to (i) the accuracy of the records of DTC, Cede or any DTC Participant with respect to any ownership interest in the Certificates, (ii) the delivery to any DTC Participant or any other person, other than a registered owner of a Certificate as shown in the Certificate Register, of any notice with respect to the Certificates, including any notice of redemption, or (iii) the payment to any DTC Participant or any other person, other than a registered owner of a Certificate as shown in the Certificate Register, of any amount with respect to the principal of or interest on the Certificates. The Village and the Certificate Registrar may treat and consider the person in whose name each Certificate is registered in the Certificate Register as the holder and absolute owner of such Certificate for the purpose of payment of principal and interest with respect to such Certificate, for the purpose of giving notices of redemption and other matters with respect to such Certificate, for the purpose of registering transfers with respect to such Certificate, and for all other purposes whatsoever. The Certificate Registrar shall pay all principal of and interest on the Certificates only to or upon the order of the respective registered owners of the Certificates, as shown in the Certificate Register, or their respective attorneys duly authorized in writing, and all such payments shall be valid and effective to fully satisfy and discharge the Village's obligations with respect to payment of the principal of and interest on the Certificates to the extent of the sum or sums so paid. No person

other than a registered owner of a Certificate as shown in the Certificate Register, shall receive a Certificate evidencing the obligation of the Village to make payments of principal and interest with respect to any Certificate. Upon delivery by DTC to the Certificate Registrar of written notice to the effect that DTC has determined to substitute a new nominee in place of Cede, and subject to the provisions in Section 6 hereof with respect to the payment of interest to the registered owners of Certificates at the close of business on the 15th day of the month next preceding the applicable interest payment date, the name "Cede" in this Ordinance shall refer to such new nominee of DTC.

In the event that (i) the Village determines that DTC is incapable of discharging its responsibilities described herein and in the Representation Letter, (ii) the agreement among the Village, the Certificate Registrar and DTC evidenced by the Representation Letter shall be terminated for any reason or (iii) the Village determines that it is in the best interests of the beneficial owners of the Certificates that they be able to obtain certificated Certificates, the Village shall notify DTC and DTC Participants of the availability through DTC of certificated Certificates and the Certificates shall no longer be restricted to being registered in the Certificate Register in the name of Cede, as nominee of DTC. At that time, the Village may determine that the Certificates shall be registered in the name of and deposited with such other depository operating a universal book-entry system, as may be acceptable to the Village, or such depository's agent or designee, and if the Village does not select such alternate universal bookentry system, then the Certificates may be registered in whatever name or names registered owners of Certificates transferring or exchanging Certificates shall designate, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5(a) hereof.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Ordinance to the contrary, so long as any Certificate is registered in the name of Cede, as nominee of DTC, all payments with respect to principal of and interest on such Certificate and all notices with respect to such Certificate shall be made and given, respectively, in the name provided in the Representation Letter.

- Section 6. Redemption. (a) Optional Redemption. All or a portion of the Certificates due on and after the date, if any, specified in the Certificate Order, shall be subject to redemption prior to maturity at the option of the Village from any available funds, as a whole or in part, and if in part in integral multiples of \$5,000 in any order of their maturity as determined by the Village (less than all of the Certificates of a single maturity to be selected by the Certificate Registrar), on the date specified in the Certificate Order, and on any date thereafter, at the redemption price of par plus accrued interest to the redemption date.
- (b) Mandatory Redemption. The Certificates maturing on the date or dates, if any, indicated in the Certificate Order shall be subject to mandatory redemption, in integral multiples of \$5,000 selected by lot by the Certificate Registrar, at a redemption price of par plus accrued

interest to the redemption date for the Certificates on the dates of the years, if any, and in the principal amounts, if any, as indicated in the Certificate Order. The principal amounts of Certificates to be mandatorily redeemed in each year may be reduced through the earlier optional redemption thereof, with any partial optional redemptions of such Certificates credited against future mandatory redemption requirements in such order of the mandatory redemption dates as the Village may determine. In addition, on or prior to the 60th day preceding any mandatory redemption date, the Certificate Registrar may, and if directed by the Board shall, purchase Certificates required to be retired on such mandatory redemption date. Any such Certificates so purchased shall be cancelled and the principal amount thereof shall be credited against the mandatory redemption required on such next mandatory redemption date.

(c) General. The Certificates shall be redeemed only in the principal amount of \$5,000 and integral multiples thereof. The Village shall, at least forty-five (45) days prior to any optional redemption date (unless a shorter time period shall be satisfactory to the Certificate Registrar) notify the Certificate Registrar of such redemption date and of the principal amount and maturity or maturities of Certificates to be redeemed. For purposes of any redemption of less than all of the outstanding Certificates of a single maturity, the particular Certificates or portions of Certificates to be redeemed shall be selected by lot by the Certificate Registrar from the Certificates of such maturity by such method of lottery as the Certificate Registrar shall deem fair and appropriate; provided that such lottery shall provide for the selection for redemption of Certificates or portions thereof so that any \$5,000 Certificate or \$5,000 portion of a Certificate shall be as likely to be called for redemption as any other such \$5,000 Certificate or \$5,000 portion. The Certificate Registrar shall make such selection upon the earlier of the irrevocable deposit of funds with an escrow agent sufficient to pay the redemption price of the Certificates to be redeemed or the time of the giving of official notice of redemption.

The Certificate Registrar shall promptly notify the Village in writing of the Certificates or portions of Certificates selected for redemption and, in the case of any Certificate selected for partial redemption, the principal amount thereof to be redeemed.

Section 7. Redemption Procedure. Unless waived by any holder of Certificates to be redeemed, notice of the call for any such redemption shall be given by the Certificate Registrar on behalf of the Village by mailing the redemption notice by first class mail at least thirty (30) days and not more than sixty (60) days prior to the date fixed for redemption to the registered owner of the Certificate or Certificates to be redeemed at the address shown on the Certificate Register or at such other address as is furnished in writing by such registered owner to the Certificate Registrar.

All notices of redemption shall state:

- (1) the redemption date,
- (2) the redemption price,
- (3) if less than all outstanding Certificates are to be redeemed, the identification(and, in the case of partial redemption, the respective principal amounts) of the Certificates to be redeemed,
- (4) that on the redemption date the redemption price will become due and payable upon each such Certificate or portion thereof called for redemption, and that interest thereon shall cease to accrue from and after said date,
- (5) the place where such Certificates are to be surrendered for payment of the redemption price, which place of payment shall be the principal office of the Certificate Registrar, and
- (6) such other information then required by custom, practice or industry standard. Unless moneys sufficient to pay the redemption price of the Certificates to be redeemed at the option of the Village shall have been received by the Certificate Registrar prior to the giving of such notice of redemption, such notice may, at the option of the Village, state that said redemption shall be conditional upon the receipt of such moneys by the Certificate Registrar on or prior to the date fixed for redemption. If such moneys are not received, such notice shall be of no force and effect, the Village shall not redeem such Certificates, and the Certificate Registrar shall give notice, in the same manner in which the notice of redemption shall have been given, that such moneys were not so received and that such Certificates will not be redeemed. Otherwise, prior to any redemption date, the Village shall deposit with the Certificate Registrar an amount of money sufficient to pay the redemption price of all the Certificates or portions of Certificates which are to be redeemed on that date.

Subject to the provisions for a conditional redemption described above, notice of redemption having been given as aforesaid, the Certificates or portions of Certificates so to be redeemed shall, on the redemption date, become due and payable at the redemption price therein specified, and from and after such date (unless the Village shall default in the payment of the redemption price) such Certificates or portions of Certificates shall cease to bear interest. Upon surrender of such Certificates for redemption in accordance with said notice, such Certificates shall be paid by the Certificate Registrar at the redemption price. Installments of interest due on or prior to the redemption date shall be payable as herein provided for payment of interest. Upon surrender for any partial redemption of any Certificate, there shall be prepared for the registered holder a new Certificate or Certificates of the same maturity in the amount of the unpaid principal.

If any Certificate or portion of Certificate called for redemption shall not be so paid upon surrender thereof for redemption, the principal shall, until paid, bear interest from the redemption date at the rate borne by the Certificate or portion of Certificate so called for redemption. All Certificates which have been redeemed shall be cancelled and destroyed by the Certificate Registrar and shall not be reissued.

The Certificates issued by the Village in connection with the Refunding have been issued in evidence of the indebtedness incurred pursuant to a certain Installment Purchase Agreement (the "Agreement"), dated as of May 2, 2013, entered into by and between the Village and the Village Treasurer, as Seller-Nominee, to which reference is hereby expressly made for further definitions and terms and to all the provisions of which the holder by the acceptance of this Certificate assents.

The Certificates are issued in fully registered form in Authorized Denominations. This Certificate may be exchanged at the corporate trust office of the Certificate Registrar for a like aggregate principal amount of Certificates of the same maturity of other Authorized Denominations, upon the terms set forth in the Certificate Ordinance. The Certificate Registrar shall not be required to transfer or exchange any Certificate during the period

beginning at the close of business on the 15th day of the month next preceding any interest payment date on such Certificate and ending at the opening of business on such interest payment date[, nor to transfer or exchange any Certificate after notice calling such Certificate for redemption has been mailed, nor during a period of fifteen (15) days next preceding mailing of a notice of redemption of any Certificates].

The Village and the Certificate Registrar may deem and treat the Registered Owner hereof as the absolute owner hereof for the purpose of receiving payment of or on account of principal hereof and interest due hereon and for all other purposes and neither the Village nor the Certificate Registrar shall be affected by any notice to the contrary.

It is hereby certified and recited that all conditions, acts and things required by law to exist or to be done precedent to and in the issuance of this Certificate did exist, have happened, been done and performed in regular and due form and time as required by law; that the indebtedness of the Village, including the issue of certificates of which this is one, does not exceed any limitation imposed by law; that the obligation to make payments due hereon is a general obligation of the Village payable from any funds of the Village legally available for such purpose, and that the Village shall appropriate funds annually and in a timely manner so as to provide for the making of all payments hereon when due; however, this Certificate shall be valid whether or not an appropriation with respect thereto is included in any annual or supplemental appropriation approved by the Village.

Section 9. Sale of Certificates. The Village President is hereby authorized to proceed without any further authorization or direction from the Board, to sell the Certificates upon the terms as prescribed in this Ordinance. The Certificates hereby authorized shall be executed as in this Ordinance provided as soon after the delivery of the Certificate Order as may be, and thereupon be deposited with the Village Treasurer, and, after authentication thereof by the Certificate Registrar, be by the Village Treasurer delivered to the purchaser thereof, upon receipt of the purchase price therefor, plus any accrued interest, if any, to date of delivery.

The purchaser of the Certificates shall be Stifel, Nicolaus & Company, Incorporated, Chicago, Illinois, and Cabrera Capital Markets, LLC, Chicago, Illinois (the "Purchaser").

Prior to the sale of the Certificates, the Village President and the Village Clerk are each hereby authorized to approve and execute a commitment for the purchase of a Municipal Bond Insurance Policy (as hereinafter defined), to further secure the Certificates, as long as the present value of the fee to be paid for the Municipal Bond Insurance Policy (using as a discount rate the expected yield on the Certificates treating the fee paid as interest on the Certificates) is less than the present value of the interest reasonably expected to be saved on the Certificates over the term of the Certificates as a result of the Municipal Bond Insurance Policy.

Upon the sale of the Certificates, the Village President shall prepare a Certificate Order which shall include the pertinent details of the sale as provided herein (the "Certificate Order"). In the Certificate Order, the Village President shall find and determine that the Certificates have been sold at such price and bear interest at such rates that either the true interest cost (yield) or the net interest rate received upon the sale of the Certificates does not exceed the maximum rate otherwise authorized by applicable law and that the net present value debt service savings to the Village as a result of the issuance of the Certificates and the refunding of the Refunded Certificates is not less than 3.0% of the principal amount of the Refunded Certificates. The Certificate Order shall be entered into the records of the Village and made available to the Board at the next regular meeting thereof; but such action shall be for information purposes only, and the Board shall have no right or authority at such time to approve or reject such sale as evidenced in the Certificate Order.

Upon the sale of the Certificates, as evidenced by the execution and delivery of the Certificate Order, the Village President and Village Clerk, and any other officers of the Village, as shall be appropriate, shall be and are hereby authorized and directed to approve or execute, or both, such documents of sale of the Certificates as may be necessary, including, without limitation, the contract for the sale of the Certificates between the Village and the Purchaser (the "Certificate Purchase Agreement"). Prior to the execution and delivery of the Certificate Purchase Agreement, the Village President shall find and determine that no person holding any office of the Village, either by election or appointment, is in any manner interested, directly or

indirectly, in his or her own name or in the name of any other person, association, trust or corporation, in the Certificate Purchase Agreement.

The Certificates before being issued shall be registered, numbered and countersigned by the Certificate Registrar, such registration being made in a book provided for that purpose, in which shall be entered the record of the ordinance authorizing the Board to borrow said money and a description of the Certificates issued, including the number, date, to whom issued, amount, rate of interest and when due.

The use by the Purchaser of any Term Sheet, Private Placement Memorandum, Preliminary Official Statement, or final Official Statement relating to the Certificates (the "Official Statement") is hereby ratified, approved and authorized; the execution and delivery thereof is hereby authorized; and the officers of the Board are hereby authorized to take any action as may be required on the part of the Village to consummate the transactions contemplated by the Certificate Purchase Agreement, this Ordinance, any Term Sheet, any Private Placement Memorandum, any Official Statement, and the Certificates.

Section 10. Use of Certificate Proceeds. Any accrued interest received on the delivery of the Certificates is hereby appropriated for the purpose of paying first interest due on the Certificates and is hereby ordered deposited into the "Series 2021A Certificates Fund" (the "Certificate Fund"), which shall be the fund for the payment of the principal of and interest on the Certificates. Funds lawfully available for the purpose of paying the principal of and interest on the Certificates shall be deposited into the Certificate Fund and used solely and only for such purpose.

The principal proceeds of the Certificates and any premium received on the delivery of the Certificates, together with such additional amounts as may be necessary from the general funds of the Village, are hereby appropriated to pay the costs of issuance of the Certificates and for the purpose of refunding the Refunded Certificates, and that portion thereof not needed to pay such costs of issuance is hereby ordered deposited (i) with the paying agent for the Prior Certificates to be held in case thereby until the redemption date of the Refunded Certificates, or (ii) into an escrow account pursuant to an escrow agreement (the "Escrow Agreement") to be entered into between the Village and the escrow agent, the same being a bank or trust company as set forth in any Certificate Order (the "Escrow Agent"). At the time of the issuance of the Certificates, the costs of issuance of the Certificates may be paid by the Purchaser on behalf of the Village from the proceeds of the Certificates.

The portion of the Prior Certificates which constitute Refunded Certificates shall be set forth in the Certificate Order, for the purpose of paying the principal of and interest on the Refunded Certificates as such become due upon redemption on the date set forth in the Certificate Order.

Section 11. Non-Arbitrage and Tax-Exemption. The Village hereby covenants that it will not take any action, omit to take any action or permit the taking or omission of any action within its control (including, without limitation, making or permitting any use of the proceeds of the Certificates) if taking, permitting or omitting to take such action would cause any of the Certificates to be an arbitrage bond or a private activity bond within the meaning of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), or would otherwise cause the interest on the Certificates to be included in the gross income of the recipients thereof for federal income tax purposes. The Village acknowledges that, in the event of an examination by the Internal Revenue Service (the "IRS") of the exemption from Federal income taxation for interest paid on the Certificates, under present rules, the Village may be treated as a "taxpayer" in such examination and agrees that it will respond in a commercially reasonable manner to any inquiries from the IRS in connection with such an examination.

The Village also agrees and covenants with the purchasers and holders of the Certificates from time to time outstanding that, to the extent possible under Illinois law, it will comply with whatever federal tax law is adopted in the future which applies to the Certificates and affects the tax-exempt status of the Certificates.

The Board hereby authorizes the officials of the Village responsible for issuing the Certificates to make such further covenants and certifications regarding the specific use of the proceeds of the Certificates as approved by the Board and as may be necessary to assure that the use thereof will not cause the Certificates to be arbitrage bonds and to assure that the interest on the Certificates will be exempt from federal income taxation. In connection therewith, the Village and the Board further agree: (a) through their officers, to make such further specific covenants, representations as shall be truthful, and assurances as may be necessary or advisable; (b) to consult with counsel approving the Certificates and to comply with such advice as may be given; (c) to pay to the United States, as necessary, such sums of money representing required rebates of excess arbitrage profits relating to the Certificates; (d) to file such forms, statements, and supporting documents as may be required and in a timely manner; and (e) if deemed necessary or advisable by their officers, to employ and pay fiscal agents, financial advisors, attorneys, and other persons to assist the Village in such compliance.

Section 12. List of Certificateholders. The Certificate Registrar shall maintain a list of the names and addresses of the holders of all Certificates and upon any transfer shall add the name and address of the new Certificateholder and eliminate the name and address of the transferor Certificateholder.

Section 13. Call of the Refunded Certificates. In accordance with the redemption provisions of the ordinance authorizing the issuance of the Refunded Certificates, the Village by

the Board does hereby make provision for the payment of and does hereby call (subject only to the delivery of the Certificates) the Refunded Certificates for redemption on such date as set forth in the Certificate Order.

- Section 14. Duties of Certificate Registrar. If requested by the Certificate Registrar, the Village President and Village Clerk are authorized to execute the Certificate Registrar's standard form of agreement between the Village and the Certificate Registrar with respect to the obligations and duties of the Certificate Registrar hereunder which may include the following:
 - (a) to act as certificate registrar, authenticating agent, paying agent and transfer agent as provided herein;
 - (b) to maintain a list of Certificateholders as set forth herein and to furnish such list to the Village upon request, but otherwise to keep such list confidential;
 - (c) to give notice of redemption of Certificates as provided herein;
 - (d) to cancel and/or destroy Certificates which have been paid at maturity or upon earlier redemption or submitted for exchange or transfer;
 - (e) to furnish the Village at least annually a certificate with respect to Certificates cancelled and/or destroyed; and
 - (f) to furnish the Village at least annually an audit confirmation of Certificates paid, Certificates outstanding and payments made with respect to interest on the Certificates.

Section 15. Continuing Disclosure Undertaking. The Village President is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute and deliver a Continuing Disclosure Undertaking under Section (b)(5) of Rule 15c2-12 adopted by the Securities and Exchange Commission pursuant to the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the "Continuing Disclosure Undertaking"). When the Continuing Disclosure Undertaking is executed and delivered on behalf of the Village as herein provided, the Continuing Disclosure Undertaking will be binding on the Village and the officers, employees and agents of the Village are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to do all such acts and things and to execute all such documents as may be necessary to carry out and comply with the provisions of the Continuing Disclosure Undertaking as executed. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Ordinance, the sole remedy for failure to comply with the Continuing Disclosure Undertaking shall be the ability of the beneficial owner of any Certificate to seek

mandamus or specific performance by court order to cause the Village to comply with its obligations under the Continuing Disclosure Undertaking.

Section 16. Municipal Bond Insurance. In the event the payment of principal and interest on the Certificates is insured pursuant to a municipal bond insurance policy (the "Municipal Bond Insurance Policy") issued by a bond insurer (the "Bond Insurer"), and as long as such Municipal Bond Insurance Policy shall be in full force and effect, the Village and the Certificate Registrar agree to comply with such usual and reasonable provisions regarding presentment and payment of the Certificates, subrogation of the rights of the Certificateholders to the Bond Insurer upon payment of the Certificates by the Bond Insurer, amendment hereof, or other terms, as approved by the President of the Board on advice of counsel, his or her approval to constitute full and complete acceptance by the Village of such terms and provisions under authority of this Section.

The Village President is hereby authorized to execute agreements with all of the financing participants on behalf of the Village.

Section 18. Supplemental Documents.
