WHEREAS, Public Act 102-0689 authorizes the Village to impose a fee for the operation of a video gaming terminal not in excess of \$250.00 per year; and

WHEREAS, Public Act 102-0689 requires the cost of any such fee imposed by the Village to be shared equally between the terminal operator and the applicable licensed establishment; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park (the “*Village Code*”) when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village to amend the text of the Village Code as herein specified to align with the amendments in Public Act 102-0689.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and

correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 3-3H-3 (“*License Fee*”) of Article H (“*Video Gaming Terminals*”) of Chapter Three (“*Amusements*”) of Title Three (“*Business and License Regulations*”) of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

3-3H-3. - License fee.

The annual ~~license~~ fee for each video gaming terminal operated within the village shall be as provided in section 11-1-3 of this code. The cost of this fee shall be shared equally between the terminal operator and the applicable licensed establishment. The fee shall be paid each year on or before April 30 in conjunction with the ~~licensee's~~ licensed establishment's application for or renewal of a liquor license. The loss or suspension of the state video gaming terminal license will automatically result in the loss or suspension of the village video gaming terminal license without any refund fee.

Section 3. Section 11-1-3 (“*Schedule B-2—Licenses and Fees Administered by General Administrative Departments.*”) of Chapter One (“*Fees, Rates and Charges*”) of Title Eleven (“*Fees*”) of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

11-1-3. - Schedule B-2—Licenses and fees administered by general administrative departments.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK
COUNTY, ILLINOIS AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2122-G-25
(AMENDING SALARY SCHEDULE ORDINANCE)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2021, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) approved Ordinance Number 2122-G-25 entitled “*An Ordinance of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois Establishing Salary Schedules and Other Compensation*” (the “*Salary Schedule Ordinance*”), as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find it necessary to amend the Salary Schedule Ordinance in order to accurately reflect salary schedule adjustments and the reassignment of duties amongst personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The Salary Schedule Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

Section 3(D). A non-union exempt employee with over thirty-five (35) years of active-duty service with the Village who dies while employed on a full-time basis shall receive one (1) year of annual salary. In addition, if a non-union exempt employee with over thirty-five (35) years of active-duty service with the Village participated in the Village's health and dental dependent coverage insurance program at the time of death, said employee's spouse and/or dependents shall be eligible to continue participation until such time as the spouse reaches the age of sixty-five and/or dependents the age of twenty-six, or for such time as deemed eligible under the Village's health and dental insurance plan. To maintain eligibility an amount equal to twenty percent (20%) of the health and dental insurance premiums or such applicable amount as assessed to all employees for similar insurance coverage must be paid monthly to the Village. Section 3(D) shall not apply to any elected official.

Section 3. The amendment set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect retroactive to February 1, 2022.

Section 4. The remaining provisions and terms as contained in the Salary Schedule Ordinance are not altered, amended, or otherwise modified by this Ordinance and remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 6. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village.
