NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 11-1-5 ("Schedule D; Miscellaneous Fees for Village Services") of Chapter 1 ("Fees, Rates and Charges") of Title 11 ("Fees") of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

11-1-5. Schedule D: Miscellaneous fees for village services.

The following is a fee schedule relative to various municipal services and fees as regulated by the village through the various departments and agencies of the village as indicated:

\$350.00 per space
\$600.00 per space
\$1000.00 per space
\$2000.00 per space

Section 3. This Ordinance, and its parts, are declared to be severable and any section, paragraph, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance that is declared invalid shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE OF FRANKLIN PARK WITH REGARD TO CONFLICTS WITH ORDINANCES ADOPTED BY THE COUNTY OF COOK REGULATING MINIMUM WAGE, EARNED SICK LEAVE AND PAID LEAVE

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2016, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook adopted Ordinance 16-5768, entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Earned Sick Leave for Employees in Cook County," that requires private employers in Cook County to provide a minimum number of paid sick days to employees; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2016, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook adopted Ordinance 16-4229, entitled "An Ordinance Creating a Minimum Wage in Cook County," establishing a minimum hourly wage to be paid by private employers in Cook County; and

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2017, the Village adopted Ordinance Number 1718-VC-11, entitled "An Ordinance of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, Amending

Title Three of the Village Code of Franklin Park Regulating Minimum Hourly Wages and Paid Sick Leave" that served to opt out of Cook County Ordinance 16-5768 and Cook County Ordinance 16-4229; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2023, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook adopted Ordinance Amendment 24-0583, entitled "Cook County Paid Leave Ordinance" that requires employers in Cook County to provide a minimum amount of paid leave to employees; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly enacted the Paid Leave for All Workers Act, 820 ILCS 192/1 *et seq.*, (the "*PLAWA*") effective on January 1, 2024, which requires employers in the State of Illinois to provide paid leave to their employees; and

WHEREAS, the Village finds that Cook County Ordinance 16-5768, Cook County Ordinance 16-4229, and Cook County Ordinance 24-0583 (collectively the "Cook County Ordinances") unnecessarily place different requirements on employers within the Village given current uniform regulations and requirements under Federal and State law; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 6(c) of the Illinois Constitution provides that if "a home rule county ordinance conflicts with an ordinance of a municipality, the municipal ordinance shall prevail within its jurisdiction;" and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Village's authority under Article VII, Section 6(c) of the Illinois Constitution, the Corporate Authorities find it in the best interest in the health, safety, and welfare of its residents to amend the Village Code of Franklin Park to clearly define the minimum wage, sick leave, and paid leave regulations and requirements that apply to employers and employees in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that the Cook County Ordinances place an undue burden on employers in the Village because employers in adjacent and nearby communities with business districts in the O'Hare industrial development market have or intend on opting out of the Cook County Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that employers in the Village will also be placed in a competitive disadvantage because the Village borders the County of DuPage, wherein which no employer is subject to the additional regulations and requirements contained in the Cook County Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, because employment requirements are evenly applied throughout the State under PLAWA, regulations based solely on the geographical location of a business causes an employer in the Village to adhere to additional requirements while an employer operating a business across a street or a block away in a different community or county is not subject to such requirements; and

WHEREAS, due to the existing disparities between employers whose business is located in the Village and employers whose business is located in nearby and adjacent communities, the Corporate Authorities believe that it is in the best interests of the Village to opt out of the Cook County Ordinances so that the same Federal and State employment regulations and requirements under PLAWA apply to employers in the Village and throughout the State of Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their

entirety.

Section 2. The Corporate Authorities find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the Village as well as in the public interest.

Section 3. Chapter 41 ("Conflicts with Home Rule Ordinances of County of Cook") of Title 3 ("Business and License Regulations") of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the following underlined language to read, as follows:

CHAPTER 41 CONFLICTS WITH HOME RULE ORDINANCES OF COUNTY OF COOK.

3-41-1: DEFINITIONS:

For the purposes of this chapter the following words as used herein shall be construed to have the meanings herein ascribed thereto, as follows:

EMPLOYEE: Shall mean an individual permitted or hired to work by an employer regardless of the number of persons the employer employs, or the number of hours worked.

EMPLOYER: Shall mean any person, firm, partnership, corporation, association, or entity employing one or more employees, or seeking to employ one or more employees, if the employer has its principal place of business within the Village or does business within the Village. The term EMPLOYER shall include: 1) the government of the United States or a corporation wholly owned by the government of the United States; 2) an Indian tribe or a corporation wholly owned by an Indian tribe; 3) the government of the State or any agency or department thereof; or 4) any unit of local government, village, or school district.

3-41-2: CONFLICT WITH HOME RULE ORDINANCES OF COUNTY OF COOK REGARDING SICK LEAVE, PAID LEAVE AND MINIMUM WAGE REQUIREMENTS:

(A) An employer located within the Village shall comply with all federal and state employment laws and regulations with regard to paid sick leave, paid leave, and the payment of minimum hourly wage. Employee eligibility for paid sick leave, paid leave, and payment of minimum hourly wage shall be pursuant to all federal and state employment laws and regulations, as such may exist from time to time.

- (B) No additional obligations with regard to paid sick leave, paid leave, or payment of minimum hourly wage, including, without limitation, any additional obligations adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook, including but not limited to Cook County Ordinances 16-5768, 16-4229, and 24-0583, as from time to time amended, shall apply to an employer located within the Village, and the Village opts out of any such regulations or requirements, except those required by federal and state law or the Village.
- Section 4. The amendment set forth in Section 3 of this Ordinance amending the Village Code of Franklin Park shall be in full force and effect retroactive to December 31, 2023.
- **Section 5**. This Ordinance, and its parts, are declared to be severable and any section, paragraph, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance that is declared invalid shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 6**. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- **Section 7**. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval to ensure that the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village is duly protected.

Section 1-2-1-1 ("Commencement of Terms of Office") of Chapter 2 ("Administration in General") of Title 1 ("Administrative") of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the following underlined language to read, as follows:

1-2-1-1. - Commencement of terms of office.

The terms of all elected municipal officials officers shall commence at the first regular of special meeting of the corporate authorities of the village in the month of June and occurring after receipt of the official election results from the Cook County clerk.

- **Section 4.** This Ordinance, and its parts, are declared to be severable and any section, paragraph, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance that is declared invalid shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 5**. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- **Section 6**. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

In Illinois, property tax bills received by taxpayers are based on a simple equation: cost of government divided by the total taxable value of property equals the property tax rate. It is the total valuation of property, the denominator in the equation, that plays a crucial role in determining tax burden on local taxpayers. If a local district has significant economic growth, the tax burden for local taxpayers in the district eases as the value of taxable property increases. If a local district is unable to create a successful economic development strategy, then with the cost of government rising, the taxpayers will realize increased tax burden. Those districts that have long-range economic development strategies can mitigate the increasing cost of government and minimize increasing tax burdens. A key research question for local districts is whether their economic development strategies continue to grow to meet present and future needs, thereby minimizing the tax burdens on their taxpayers.

In 2016-2017, Myer Blank was the principal author of a report for the Village of Franklin Park on the status of its long-range economic growth strategy (see attached). Since that time, there have been changes impacting the property tax system: a new Assessor in Cook County, Covid, high inflation, etc. As follow-up, the question is whether the Village of Franklin Park's economic growth strategy is viable given the changes to the property tax system. Questions to be researched include:

- Impact of past Village of Franklin Park economic initiatives, specifically property tax incentives;
- Analysis of the Village of Franklin Park's levy, tax rate, and taxable value (equalized assessed value); and
- Changes to the proportion of taxes being paid by residential versus commercial taxpayers.

To follow-up on the initial research conducted for the Village of Franklin Park, Myer Blank, Tax Consulting, LLC, is proposing a consulting contract with the Village of Franklin Park to provide research and author a report for the Village of Franklin Park. The contract is for work to be performed from January 1, 2024, through March 31, 2024. Mr. Blank will dedicate 15 hours per work to researching an agreed upon research agenda for the Village of Franklin Park. He shall be paid \$4,000 per month, for the three-month period for a total of \$12,000. The Village of Franklin Park and Mr. Blank have the rights to terminate this agreement at any point.
