The committee began discussing ideas for the Leyden High School presentation in the spring, possible at Budburst and local tree keepers to present.

SFPFD Smolen explained that on November 14th there will be a zoom meeting with the Chicago Region Tree Initiative to discuss the CRTI grants.

Member Ambo presented grant information about America in Bloom, this grant beautifies that landscape around the railroad track. SFPD Smolen will discuss this grant with the engineering department.

Member Grahn will be reviewing all grants materials.

OTHER BUSINESS/ANNOUNCEMENTS

Informational door tags from the Chicago Region of Trees that explain how to care for trees will be ordered.

SFPFD Smolen contacted Ball Seed Company to inquire about seed donations for the upcoming seed swap.

Memorial Tree Program, trees will be planted by the Village of Franklin Park on parkways to honor or memorize someone. These trees will include tree care manuals.
